- 2. In case of missing parts or external damages, please contact your local dealer for replacement.


Please keep the original package for shipping in case of warranty case.


5 Use

You can control the KVM by using the switches at the front or by using Hotkeys.

The front USB port switches automatically by changing the port. The data transfer between an external device and the USB port will be interrupted in this case.

5.1 Toggle by switches

AS-21DA/ AS-41DA



The switches at the front of the device are control buttons as well as LED indicators.

You can switch between the computers by pushing the buttons. The right LEDs show the selected port. The left LEDs show the online status of these ports.

5.2 Toggle by Hotkeys

You can operate by using 4 different Hotkey Mode:

Mode 1	STRG + SHIFT (Default)
Mode 2	SCROLL
Mode 3	NUM
Mode 4	CAPS LOCK

Press first three keys at the same time.

STRG + STRG

Forwards to next active port.

"HOTKEY" means the current Hotkey.

Press all keys one after another.

Fault	Possible reason(s)	Help
Keyboard/ Mouse/ Monitor doesn´t work	Cable not connected	Check all cables
	Computers off	Check if Computer is switched on
	Computer USB port defective	Connect the switch to another USB port
	DVI Port or graphics adapter faulty	Connect the switch to another computer
	Keyboard/ Mouse or Monitor faulty	Connect another mouse/ keyboard or monitor
	Switch defective	Change the switch at your dealer

Please unplug power cord generally when working inside the Computer.

In case of checking the electric socket exists risk of electric strike.

Leave work on mains supply only authorized experts.
